*Reminders:

1. Private CLIF are determined using one of these methods: same method as public schools, income surveys with extrapolation, proportionality, comparable data from a different source, an equated measure.



- 2. "E. Equitable Share Amount" includes all funding for services (family engagement is 1% of equitable share amount; administrative costs are determined in consultation and cannot exceed 10% of the allocation when combined with public administrative costs (which include indirect costs); professional development, if applicable; and instructional services).
- 3. Private schools may also have unspent funds from prior year.
